Fiscal Officer Nancy Yackee presented the following financial reports for review and signatures and/or initials of the Trustees: 11/04/22-11/17/22 Payment Listing, Receipt Listing, Appropriation Status, Appropriation Budget, Revenue Status, Revenue Budget, Cash Summary by Fund. A copy of the Fund Status Report was given to each Trustee.

Thomas Fenton of 3118 SH 108, Wauseon was in attendance. He discussed the camper that is on the property and that it is registered. Clinton Township zoning law state he cannot have a camper on the property that he resides in. He feels he is being harassed. Trustee Hite explained to Mr. Fenton the process that we are following and we are following the zoning laws for Clinton Township. Mr. Fenton commented that everything is cleaned up and he will be putting fencing up. Mr. Fenton also commented that he is looking into other sites to place his camper. Jason Fisher, zoning inspector will discuss this matter with the Prosecutor.

OLD BUSINESS

The Pettisville Cemetery and Aeschliman Cemetery signs will be in place in December.

ZONING

There have been a couple of building permits filed.

The Eby garage that did not have a permit or variance filed was taken down by the wind. We have not heard what he will be doing.

Potential buyers for the building on SH 108 south of Wauseon on the west side between C and D. They are looking at a zoning change.

FIRE

Truck 802 that is currently being refurbished need an addition repair costing \$25,098.

RESOLUTION 39-2022-11-17-Mr. Hite made a motion to pay for the additional repair when the truck is delivered in the Spring of 2023. This will be paid directly from the fire fund and not part of the loan for the refurbish. A second motion was made by Mr. Neuenschwander.

The refurbished amount for Truck 802 is \$422,315 and to be done in April or May of 2023.
