RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

(Revised Code, Sec. 5705.19, .191, .194, .25, .26)

The Board of Township Trustees of Clinton Township, Fulton, County, Ohio, met in REGULAR session on the 2nd day of July, 2026, at the Clinton Township Office with the following members present:

Mr. Kevin Demaline moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Clinton Township, Fulton County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, said Clinton Township has received and reviewed the certification from the Fulton County Auditor as to the total current valuation of this subdivision and the dollar amount of the revenue that be generated by the specified number of mills; there be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustee of the Township of Clinton, Fulton County, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Clinton Township (including the City of Wauseon) for the purpose of maintenance and operations of the cemeteries of Clinton Township at a rate not exceeding fifteen one hundredths of a mill (0.15) mills for each one dollars of valuation, which amounts to no dollars and fifteen hundredths cents (\$.015 cents) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of 5 years, which said levy is a RENEWAL tax of fifteen hundredths (.15) mills; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said Clinton Township proceed with the levy of said tax and the question of levying the RENEWAL tax be submitted to the electors of said Clinton Township (including the City of Wauseon) at the GENERAL election to be held at the usual voting places within said Clinton Township, Fulton County, Ohio on the 3rd day of November, 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list commencing of Tax Year 2026, first due in calendar year 2027, if a MAJORITY of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Fiscal Officer of this Board of Township Trustees be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections and County Auditor Fulton County, Ohio, no later than 90 days prior to the election upon which it will be voted and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

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WHEREAS, said Clinton Township has received and reviewed the certification from the Fulton County Auditor as to the total current valuation of this subdivision and the dollar amount of the revenue that be generated by the specified number of mills; there be it

RESOLVED, by the Board of Township Trustee of the Township of Clinton, Fulton County, Ohio, at least two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of Clinton Township (including the City of

Wauseon) for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section [145.48](#) or [742.34](#) of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, at a rate not exceeding one mill (1.00) mills for each one dollars of valuation, which amounts to no dollars and ten cents (\$.10 cents) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a period of 5 years, which said levy is an ADDITIONAL tax of one and zero hundredths (1.00) mills; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said Clinton Township proceed with the levy of said tax and the question of levying the ADDITIONAL tax be submitted to the electors of said Clinton Township (including the City of Wauseon) at the GENERAL election to be held at the usual voting places within said Clinton Township, Fulton County, Ohio on the 3RD day of November, 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said levy be placed upon the tax list commencing of Tax Year 2026, first due in calendar year 2027, if a MAJORITY of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Fiscal Officer of this Board of Township Trustees be and she is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections and County Auditor Fulton County, Ohio, no later than 90 days prior to the election upon which it will be voted and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
