Discussed levies to be put on the November ballot and methods for providing factual information to residents regarding the levies and the Township services and expenditures funded by levy revenue. . Delray gave us some tips of how to let the public know the facts about the levies and what the monies are used for in the Township of Clinton. An open house at the Township office was discussed and a tentative date of October 6 was set for an informational open house. The Trustees will be in attendance along with the Fiscal Officer to answer any questions the public may have.

Wauseon Fire Contract with Wauseon City, Clinton Township and Dover Township was discussed. Dover Township is satisfied with the fire service they receive. After much discussion it was decided to keep the contract the same for the next three years.

Clinton Township has received four resumes for Zoning Inspector for Clinton Township. The interviews will be scheduled for August 20 beginning at 4:00. It was decided to pay the new inspector \$450 a month.
