A copy of the Fund Status Report was given to each Trustee.

Representative from Recovery Services were in attendance to present and discuss the services that Recovery Services provide. They are interested in purchasing the building on SH 108 between C and D. It is recovery housing for women. They are looking at having 6 beds. They have grant money to provide these services. There will not need to be a zoning change done. The Trustees are all in agreement that Recovery Services locating in the building would be good.

OLD BUSINESS

The Fenton property on SH 108 is cleaned up and the trailer is gone. The Trustees feel that currently he is in compliance of the zoning regulations.

The Eby property on C and 17 is cleaned up but had new trusses delivered. Looks like he is going to begin building again but has not filed for a variance yet.

-A Pettisville sign was discussed on CO RD DE by the soccer fields on the north side. They will furnish the signage and Clinton Township will provide the poles and install the signs.
